



## Three Important Steps to Clean Green Pool

If your pool pH and Chlorine is not maintained, - your pool will become green – this is Algae. When this occurs, it is important to use effective algae killer (**ALGIECIDES**).

Firstly –

- Top up the pool so you have enough residual water to Backwash later.
- Balance the pH – it is important to get your pool pH to 7.2-7.4 as Bioguard Chemicals are designed to work within these parameters.

### THREE EASY STEPS:

#### Step 1. Destroy the algae Growth.

It is recommended to use Multi - spectrum algaecide such **MSA II algaecide** which kill all types of algae. To make sure the chemical works effectively;-



1. Brush all pool surface to expose all algae to the algaecide
2. Do a backwash
3. Add **Two Ten Granular chlorine** (50,000lts pool add 500gm),, this helps to kill bacteria and shock the pool. Unstabilised chlorine is cheap and quick acting - only once the pool is stabilized do you go back to stabilised Chlorine
4. Add **Bioguard MSA II algaecide** in the area of greatest circulation add 500ml i.e. half a bottle in 50,000lts pool
5. Allow the pool pump to run as long as 48hrs.



#### Step 2. Remove the dead algae from the water

After chemical treatment, dead algae and bacteria still circulate in the swimming pool water .Therefore it is important to remove everything so to attain crystal clear water,

using **Bioguard Sparkle up**

This is a Cellulose filtration aid does a phenomenal job in restoring your pool water's sparkle! Removes fine dirt, dead algae, pollen, etc. Also helps in the actual REMOVAL of iron, copper, manganese & other heavy metals from pool water.

Can be used with ALL Filter types.

Sparkle up does NOT contain alum, so it will not change PH and traps very tiny particles. In order to remove the dead algae, Bacteria and other dirt; the following procedure should be followed



1. Turn multiport valve on filter position and add 3 x packets (200g) of **Bioguard Sparkle up** on average pool size filter through skimmer.
2. Back wash the filter after 12-24hrs of operation
3. Repeat the filter backwash until extra tiny particles have been filtered from pool.

### **Step 3.Prevent algae**

It costs far more to cure an algae problem than it does to prevent it. In order to control both algae and bacteria you have to use right product, right amount and right time

Use algaecides once a month with stabilized granular chlorine and Tablets Such as **Bioguard Ultraswim** and **Bioguard Smart tab** is rewarding compare to **Calcium hypochlorite** (unstabilized chlorine).Also remember to balance your water
